

LINCOLN PARK CAMPUS

Our Lincoln Park Campus covers 36 acres in one of Chicago's most unique and lively neighborhoods. Use this guide to help you explore all our campus has to offer. This campus is home to the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences, College of Science and Health, College of Education, School of Music and The Theatre School.

Student Life

1 CORTELYOU COMMONS Originally built in 1929, Cortelyou

Commons accommodates banquets, receptions, presentations and other large events. Student organizations often use this space for gatherings, talent shows and performances.

2 DEPAUL ART MUSEUM

The museum acquires, preserves and displays DePaul's diverse and growing collection of art and offers space for class use, programs and events. Admission is free.

3 JARVIS OPERA HALL

School of Music faculty and students often give vocal and instrumental performances in the opera hall. Before it became a performance venue, the opera hall was McClure Chapel.

4 THE QUAD

The green, grassy quad was converted from a parking lot in 1992. With its expansive space, greenery and Wi-Fi accessibility, the Quad is a favorite spot for students on nice days. Numerous events are held here each year, including our annual involvement fair and end-ofthe-year FEST concert, which has hosted popular recording artists, such as Diplo, Hellogoodbye and Wiz Khalifa.

5 RAY MEYER FITNESS AND RECREATION CENTER

"The Ray" boasts a lap pool, four-court gym, cycling and fitness studios, cardio and strength-training equipment, and a fourth-floor track with 360-degree views of the city. Membership is included in fulltime undergraduate tuition.

6 ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CHURCH St. Vincent de Paul Church was completed in 1897, one year before DePaul was founded. In addition to the regular parish masses and services, St. Vincent's hosts DePaul's well-attended Catholic Campus Ministry Mass on Sundays at 9:30 p.m.

7 SULLIVAN ATHLETIC CENTER

DePaul is a member of the BIG EAST Conference and is an NCAA Division I school. The athletic center is home to McGrath-Phillips Arena, where the women's basketball and volleyball teams play; special events, such as pep rallies and guest appearances, are held here. The Wintrust Arena in the South Loop serves as home court to DePaul men's basketball. All athletic games are free to DePaul students.

3 STUDENT CENTER

This building is the hub of on-campus student life, hosting 7,000 events annually, such as concerts, career and involvement fairs, and dances. Nestled among the three stories are a cafeteria, Brownstone's Coffee Bar, study lounges and multipurpose rooms. The building is home to the Dean of Students, Student Affairs, Office of Student Involvement and the Office of Mission and Ministry.

9 WELCOME CENTER

This building is home to Undergraduate Admission, The Office of Graduate Admission and Alumni Relations. Daily information sessions and campus tours are offered through the Welcome Center.

WISH FIELD AND CACCIATORE STADIUM

Just east of the "L" tracks is Wish Field and Cacciatore Stadium. The field features artificial turf on which the men's and women's soccer teams practice and compete; club and intramural teams also have access to this space. The women's softball team plays on the south end of the field at Cacciatore Stadium.

Academic 1 990 WEST FULLERTON

This building is home to our sociology, political science and geography departments.

12 1150 WEST FULLERTON

This academic building is home to the Department of Art, Media and Design as well as DePaul's health services clinic. A branch of the Chicago Public Library is located on the first floor.

13 ARTS AND LETTERS HALL

This facility features 47 state-of-the-art classrooms, several indoor lounge areas and an interior staircase overlooking a dramatic, four-story atrium. This building is home to our Department of English and the Department of Art History and Architecture.

13 BYRNE HALL

Named after DePaul's first president, Byrne Hall houses multiple academic programs and student service offices, including the physics and psychology departments, and DePaul Family and Community Services.

15 HOLTSCHNEIDER PERFORMANCE CENTER

The center includes teaching studios, rehearsal space, a 505-seat, acoustically optimal concert hall, two recital halls with professional-quality acoustics, and a 76-seat jazz hall with an intimate, jazz club ambiance.

16 McGOWAN NORTH

McGowan North features a computer lab, student lounge, and state-of-the-art science labs and classrooms. It is home to the Department of Biological Sciences.

17 McGOWAN SOUTH

This LEED Gold-certified building has 31 modern teaching and research labs, high-tech classrooms and a full inventory of scientific instruments. The building also features two rooftop greenhouses and a weather station. The chemistry, health sciences, and environmental sciences and studies departments are located here.

18 RICHARDSON LIBRARY

Open until 2 a.m. on the weekdays, the Richardson Library provides 1,200 study seats, three study lounges, eight group study rooms and multiple computer labs. The library is connected with over 80 other colleges and libraries in Illinois, giving students access to more than 24 million items. Other resources that are available are our special collections and archives, along with online access to DePaul's card catalog and databases.

19 SCHMITT ACADEMIC CENTER (SAC), 20 LEVAN CENTER AND 21 O'CONNELL HALL

These interconnected buildings feature classrooms, computer centers and administrative offices. In particular, the SAC is home to DePaul Central (a one-stop shop to help students manage registration, academic planning, financial aid and payment processes), the Study Abroad office, the Career Center and The Pit—a social gathering and study area with a café. The Black Cultural



Center, Latinx Cultural Center, LGBTQIA Resource Center and Asian Pacific Islander Desi American (APIDA) Center are located on the third floor of O'Connell Hall. The centers serve as a space for building community, sharing information, encouraging dialogue, and supporting student retention and success.

22 SCHOOL OF MUSIC

The School of Music building hosts classrooms, rehearsal and performance rooms, offices and a student lounge for the school. Many vocal and instrumental performances take place at the Jarvis Opera Hall and Holtschneider Performance Center.

23 THE THEATRE SCHOOL

The Theatre School was designed and developed specifically to meet the creative needs of theatre artists. It houses two theatre spaces as well as costume, makeup, prop and scene shops, rehearsal studios, lighting laboratories and new-media workshops.

Residential Housing

22 CENTENNIAL HALL

Located above Whole Foods and adjacent to the Fullerton "L" stop, Centennial Hall is in the heart of the action. The building features one- and two-bedroom apartments, some with skyline views.

25 CORCORAN HALL

Overlooking Cacciatore Stadium and Wish Field, Corcoran is a traditionalstyle residence hall with community bathrooms. Two students share a room and have access to kitchens, laundry rooms and study lounges. Corcoran consistently has a lively and active residential community.

20 COURTSIDE APARTMENTS

This Chicago row house was converted into apartments—each housing 12 students. Units have access to an outdoor deck space overlooking the building's backyard. Each unit is equipped with a full kitchen, including a dishwasher, and all residents have access to a laundry room.

27 McCABE HALL

Known for its larger-than-life St. Vincent de Paul mural painted by members of our DePaul community, McCabe Hall offers apartment- and suite-style living.

28 SANCTUARY HALL AND 29 SANCTUARY TOWN HOMES

These apartment-style residences offer full kitchens, spacious living areas and key card swipe entry for upperclassman residents.

30 SETON HALL

This primarily freshman traditional-style residence hall features loft-style rooms with large walk-in closets. Students share bathroom and shower facilities and have access to lounges; laundry and kitchen facilities located on each floor. The first floor is home to our Lincoln Park Campus bookstore.

31 SHEFFIELD SQUARE

As part of the university's apartment communities, Sheffield Square features two-, three- and four-person units each with a full kitchen, living room and bathroom.

32 UNIVERSITY HALL, 33 CLIFTON-FULLERTON HALL, 34 MUNROE HALL AND 35 BELDEN-RACINE HALL

All of these primarily freshman residence halls are suite-style, meaning two rooms share a bathroom and shower. Each floor provides a kitchen and study lounge; laundry rooms and computer labs are located in every residence hall.



LOOP CAMPUS

Our Loop Campus is located in Chicago's business center, called "The Loop" because of the elevated railway circling the area. It's the city's largest business district, making it the perfect location for our Driehaus College of Business, College of Computing and Digital Media, College of Communication, College of Law and School of Continuing and Professional Studies. The area is rich with internship and full-time job opportunities.

Student Life

1 THE MERLE RESKIN THEATRE

This beautiful 1.400-seat theatre presents performances by DePaul's Theatre School and School of Music. The stage has served as a foundation for the training of hundreds of artists.

2 WINTRUST ARENA

Wintrust Arena is the home for DePaul's men's and women's basketball teams. With 10,000 seats and 22 state-of-the-art suites, the arena can accommodate a myriad of events, including DePaul's annual commencement ceremonies.

Academic

3 55 EAST JACKSON

The university rents space for numerous offices and administrative departments, including the Office of the President.

4 CDM CENTER

The College of Computing and Digital Media Center is home to the School of Cinematic Arts, School of Computing and School of Design. The building has three different gaming labs for designing and playing games: development, PC and console. The animation lab is available for students creating both digital and cell (traditional) animation. There also is a small theatre to showcase student work and for classes to watch movies. In the basement is a gym managed by the Ray Meyer Fitness & Recreation Center.

5 DEPAUL CENTER

The DePaul Center is the anchor of DePaul's Loop Campus. The 11-floor facility, located at the corner of Jackson and State, is the home of the university's Driehaus College of Business, the main Loop library, and various offices essential to students, including DePaul Central and the Office of Admission. The Dean of Students,

Career Center, Student Government Association (SGA) and Study Abroad programs all retain offices in the DePaul Center as well.

The first floor and lower level of the DePaul Center features a full-service Barnes & Noble Bookstore that also serves as DePaul's Loop Campus academic bookstore. The main level of the DePaul Center is also host to Radio DePaul and numerous shops and eateries. The lower level is where you'll find the Esports Gaming Center, our student newspaper, The DePaulia, and the Virtual and Augmented Design Lab.

The DePaul Student Center is located on the 11th floor of the DePaul Center. DePaul Market, our main Loop cafeteria, along with the Student Union, DePaul Activities Board and University Ministry are all located here.

6 LEWIS CENTER

Lewis Center is the main home of the university's College of Law. The college's admission office and Rinn Law Library are housed at Lewis, along with the Loop branch of the undergraduate Honors Program, the University Center for Writing-based Learning, and a general use computer lab with more than 50 workstations.

7 RICHARD M. AND MAGGIE C. DALEY BUILDING

This building accommodates the College of Communication and the School of Continuing and Professional Studies. This is also home to the Center for Journalism Integrity and Excellence.

Residential Housing B UNIVERSITY CENTER (UC)

DePaul shares the UC with other local universities and houses over 250 DePaul students. The UC features a dining center, fitness center, rooftop terrace, laundry room, music practice rooms and an art studio for residents' use.
